Special Thanks to... The Bild Group for six loads of crushed rock which will be used for extending pathways in the reserve. This was a very generous donation and is much appreciated.

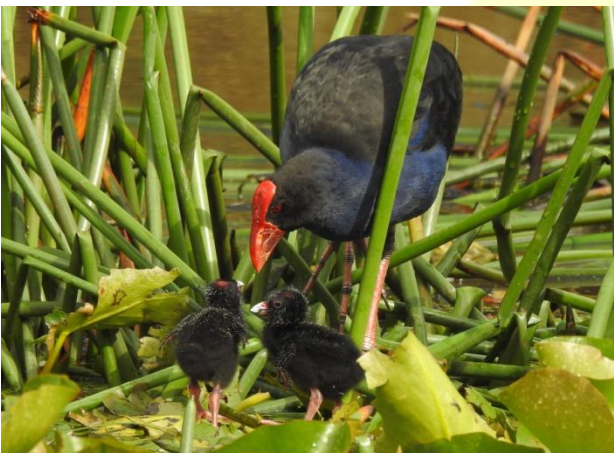


Working Bees

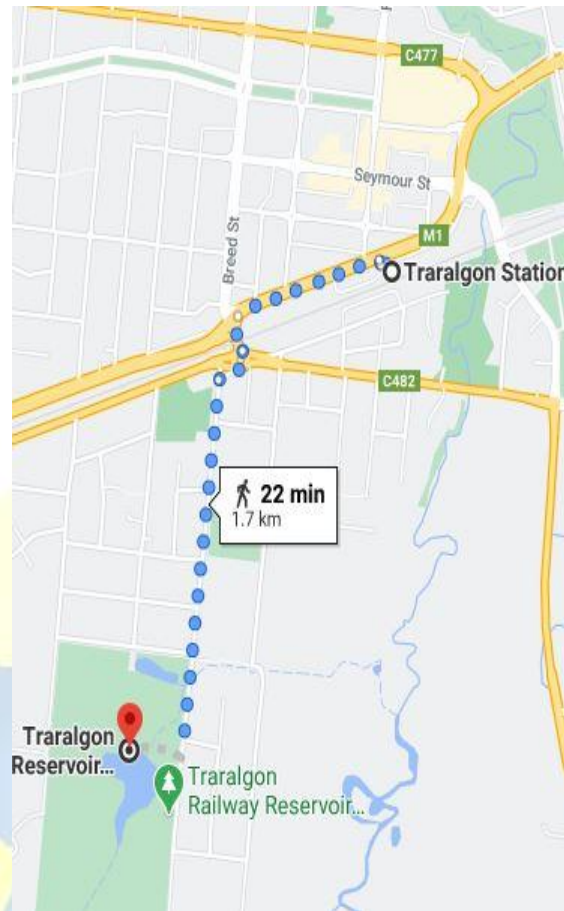
